Introduction and company overview

Strait Support Pty Ltd is a 100% Indigenous owned and managed company with a focus on increasing Indigenous participation in the workforce as well as growing capability in the Far North Queensland and Torres Strait region.

With offices in Cairns, Thursday Island and Darnley Island in the Torres Strait, Strait Support is very well positioned to support civil construction projects across the Far North.

Strait Support engages with reputable organisations to become a project partner offering various levels of support including the supply of Indigenous labour, plant and equipment hire and training solutions, right through to managing and completing entire civil construction projects.

Strait Support's mission is to increase the lack of genuine, sustainable employment and training opportunities for Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander jobseekers.

Strait Support collaborates with principal contractors to provide a structured pathway to ongoing employment success, all while assisting businesses to achieve compliance requirements for Indigenous employment and training criteria. The aim is to support, mentor and up-skill the jobseekers to develop the confidence and skills to maintain or ultimately gain permanent employment independently.

Strait Support is a 100% Indigenous owned and operated business that is genuinely focused on improving outcomes for their own people. Shane Lui, the owner of Strait Support stems from an upbringing on Darnley Island, where the basic provisions in life were non-existent and through sheer persistence and drive, he has taken on the moral responsibility to create authentic opportunities for his people and the communities throughout the Far North Queensland region.

Services

Strait Support understands every business and their needs are unique. Strait Support are continuously evolving to cater for industry demands. Therefore, as Strait Support grows, the range of services offered is expanding.

Services currently offered by Strait Support include:

Labour Hire

Strait Support is a licenced labour hire provider and can provide suitably skilled and experienced labour to assist when projects or workloads increase.

Strait Support's focus is increasing employment opportunities for Indigenous job seekers and we will advocate to place suitable Indigenous candidates first, however we will also provide non-Indigenous candidates where suited.

All candidates supplied by Strait Support will come equipped with the required personal protective equipment and will be supported through the induction process.



Plant Hire

Strait Support has a range of vehicles and plant available for both Wet Hire throughout the Torres Strait. The Skid Steers, Mini Excavators and trucks make a perfect combination for Mini Earthworks requiring:

- Site Leveling
- Driveway preparations
- Piers and Post Holes
- Haulage
- Freight Collection or Delivery









Concreting

Strait Support's skid steer loaders are equipped with hydraulic cement mixers allowing efficient and economical batching of cement to undertake concreting works in remote locations. Strait Support staff are experienced and familiar with completing concrete driveways, footings, landings and piers throughout the Torres Strait.



Fencing

Qualified and experienced staff along with Strait Support's skid steer loaders equipped with various auger attachments allow for effective fence replacement or installations.

Strait Support have completed many chain wire fence installations on various Torres Strait Islands for boundary, landfill sites, fuel stations and water ways. Fence heights have ranged from 1.5 through to 2.1, including barbed wire installs.



Building maintenance

Strait Support holds a QBCC Licence and along with a team of licenced builders and qualified carpenters, Strait Support can undertake routine or emergency building repairs and maintenance across Cairns and the Torres Strait.



Site Inspections

Strait Support is based on Darnley Island, but regularly travel to other outer islands in the Torres Strait. To avoid the costly expense of flying staff in for inspections, Strait Support can assist with remote site

inspections via camera or UAV Drone. Aerial footage can assist with accurate scoping, planning and quoting of projects.


